ABOUT THE COURSE

What does the course involve? This course provides the opportunity to study a range of topics from within childcare and education. Learners will gain an increase in knowledge and awareness of the Prevent Duty and safeguarding, including online safety, as well as recognising bullying within children and young people. It does not qualify the learner to work but it supports them in preparing for their next steps, either in training or moving towards work in the childcare sector. Learners will be supported to develop employability skills, this includes having a strong work ethic, positive attitude, effective communication skills, time management, problem-solving skills, acting as a team player, and self-confidence.
