What does the course involve? This course is designed for learners wishing to develop their understanding of the safe handling of medication. It provides a general overview of different types of medication and their uses and supports the development of knowledge surrounding the procedures for obtaining, storing, administering and disposing of medication along with the importance of accurate record-keeping.

What job roles does this qualification support?

How long does the course run?
